

God Watches Psalm 33:12-14

Preface

America is much more than just the land of the free. **America is a blessed nation with a rich history.**

However, many of us are uneasy with the America we see today. We look around and we see a country that has in many ways changed for the worse during our lifetime.

As we look around, we see corrupt, self-serving leaders obsessed with power. We see a country breeding generations of free-loaders looking for a free ride through government handouts and frivolous lawsuits.

We watch as our nation denies the very inspiration and strength of its foundation. We watch as our nation accepts one compromise after another to accommodate every extremist's point of view.

We watch as our country goes deeper and deeper into debt while it ask for more and more of America's hard working citizens.

And, we watch as our citizenry gives less and less of their time and talents to serve the God we say we love.

It is hard to be an American and watch what is happening in America today.

But someone else is watching America too.

Scripture – Read

¹² *Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he chose for his inheritance.* ¹³ *From heaven the LORD looks down and sees all mankind;* ¹⁴ *from his dwelling place he watches all who live on earth... Psalm 33:12-14 NIV*

Introduction

Illus: I remember several years ago we were on a leisurely boat ride at Ono Island when we spotted a huge Osprey perched in a nest at the top of a dead tree. Later we drove my truck around to the tree to get some pictures and a closer look at the bird. The mother Osprey was large and majestic. From the moment we stepped out of the truck, she watched our every move. If we got too close to the tree, she would get out of the nest and circle us diving down to warn us we were too close. As long as we were there, her watchful eye tracked our every move.

Our text tells us that God is watching America. Like the magnificent Osprey, God looks down upon His people with a watchful eye, tracking our every move and action.

1. God is watching America to protect her.

God has protected America because of our commitment to Him. **There are those who say America was not born out of Christianity.** Nothing could be further from the truth.

When a band of early settlers stepped off the boat they signed a compact which became known as the Mayflower Compact. The first paragraph contained the words, *"In the name of God."* The second paragraph included the words, *"For the glory of God."*

The birth of this nation was inspired by the Holy Spirit of God in the hearts of men and women whose faith rested in Jehovah God. For this reason, God has blessed and protected America.

Woodrow Wilson, our 28th President said, *"America was born a Christian nation. America was born to exemplify that devotion to the elements of righteousness which are derived from the revelations of the Holy Scripture."*

Patrick Henry said, *"It cannot be emphasized too strongly or too often that this great nation was founded by Christians, not on religion, but on the gospel of Jesus Christ."*

God watches over His people. God has protected America and He will continue to protect America as long as America worships and honors God.

I for one am sick and tired of people denying that America was founded on Christianity. We are denying our foundation.

Benjamin Franklin said, *“I see this truth – That God governs the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without his notice, it is probable that an Empire cannot rise without His aid. We have been assured, Sir, in the Sacred Writings, that except the Lord build the house they labor in vain who build it.”*

Through wars and struggles, through depressions and draughts, God watches over His people and He protects His people.

2. God is watching America to observe her.

While it is comforting to know that God is watching over His people to protect them, we must also be keenly aware God is watching to observe us.

God watches to observe our thankfulness. As God’s people, we have every reason to be thankful but **we need to be thankful to God and recognize that it is He who has blessed us.**

Illus: Several years ago I visited a man who had a building in Moss Point Mississippi that he was trying to rent. He explained that he originally built the building as a skating rink. For the first year he had more business than he could handle. The kids would line up in the parking lot to get in to skate. He told about how he got so proud that he would not accept their crumpled dollar bills. He would make them straighten the bills out before he would accept them. Eventually, skating lost its popularity and the rink was

closed. He concluded by saying, *“I would give anything for a handful of those crumpled dollar bills today.”*

As Americans, we must not take our blessings for granted. Our key to happiness and future prosperity is directly related to our gratitude toward God.

Illus: I am reminded of the fortune 500 CEO who pulled into a service station to get gas with his wife. He went inside to pay and when he came out he noticed his wife engaged in a conversation with the service station attendant. It turned out that she dated the man in high school before she met her husband.

The CEO got back in the car, and the two drove off in silence. He was feeling pretty good about himself and finally he spoke, “I bet I know what you are thinking. I bet you are thinking you sure are glad you married me, a fortune 500 CEO and not him, a service station attendant.” To which she responded, “No, I was thinking if I’d married him, he’d be a fortune 500 CEO and you would be a service station attendant.”

There are no self made people. America is not a self-made country. We owe our gratitude to God.

God watches to observe our worship. The Bible tells us God is a jealous God. He commands us to worship Him and Him only.

We are to be fervent and sincere in our worship of God. Worship isn’t for you and me, **worship is for God.** Worship isn’t about how good or even how inspired you feel when you leave. Worship is our expression of gratitude and love to our savior.

As Americans, if we have genuine gratitude, we will worship regularly and sincerely.

God watches to observe our actions. God desires for our lives to be an example to others. Our actions, the things we do daily are to bring others to Christ.

“...Continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, ¹³ for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose. Philippians 2:12-13 NIV

Illus: Too often we are like our kids on a long vacation. We are constantly asking, “Are we there yet?” We want salvation to be an instantaneous event where it happens and we are all set.

Salvation is a process by which we trust in God’s word, we obey, we grow and we learn to trust more. This is the process of fully experiencing our salvation.

God is watching to see if we are trusting Him and living according to His word.

3. God is watching America to save her.

Just as God blessed the birth of this great nation, **God also promises continued blessings but with a condition.**

¹⁴ if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 NIV

God is eager to heal our country and bless our country if we will turn to Him.

There is an underlying problem in America today. Much of our society **worships the created rather than the Creator.** We have elevated the government to a place above the very God who inspired it. In doing so, we are removing God from every public element of our society. This must change and change must begin in the church with God’s people.

The idea that Christianity and God have no place in public life is a lie fostered by Satan himself. Yet this lie has become the basis of one court decision after another.

In 1776, 11 of 13 colonies required that one had to be a Christian to be eligible to run for political office. 94% of the writings of the founding fathers contained quotations from the Holy Scriptures.

But, today Christians are intimidated by organizations such as the ACLU who is determined to remove God from public life. This must not be. We must declare our loyalty first to God and secondly to our country.

Our towns and school systems explain their lack of willingness to stand-up for God by saying they do not have the money to fight the ACLU. What does that say about our commitment to God? We should be willing to go broke standing up for God.

We must not confuse patriotism with godliness. Without godliness there will be no patriotism. Without God there will be no fairness in laws. Without God there will be no love for our neighbor. Without God there will be no respect for parents. Without God there will be no honor for the spouse. Without God there will be no government by the people and for the people. Without God there will be no free United States of America.

Without God there will be no day of independence.

It was our Second President, John Adams who wrote in 1798, *“Our constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”*

“Can the liberties of a nation be secure when we have removed a conviction that these liberties are the gift of God.” Thomas Jefferson

Today America is weak in morality because we are weak in our faith in God.

Someone must turn the tide of the United States of America. Someone must lead the people back to a fervent trust in God and His Word. Someone must declare the truth of Jesus Christ and stand firm on that foundation.

That “someone” is you and me – The Church! **The church is God’s chosen vessel to reach the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ. The responsibility rest upon us to point America back to its foundation and inspiration – God.**

God is watching!

Conclusion

Some have given up hope on America being a Christian nation. I have not given up hope.

I serve a God who is bigger than all our troubles combined.

I serve a God who would rather forgive and restore than to judge and punish.

There can be an America that once again worships and honors God in all of its endeavors.

There can be an America that once again desires to honor God on its currency, its buildings and great monuments.

There can be a nation that recognizes its laws were founded on the Holy Bible and proudly displays scripture in public places.
